Terrific Tanks

Saturday 10 November

and 1pm to 2.30pm



In Great Britain, an initial vehicle, nicknamed Little Willie was constructed during 1915 the prototype of what became the Mark 1 Tank. Although initially termed "Landships" they were named "tanks", to preserve secrecy. Learn about the tank and as part of our special WW1 session Try make your own moving tank!
